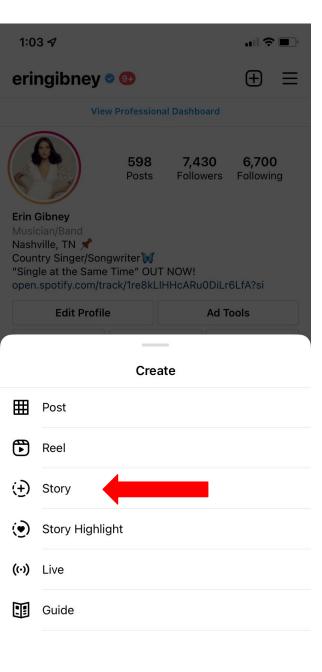
What are stories?

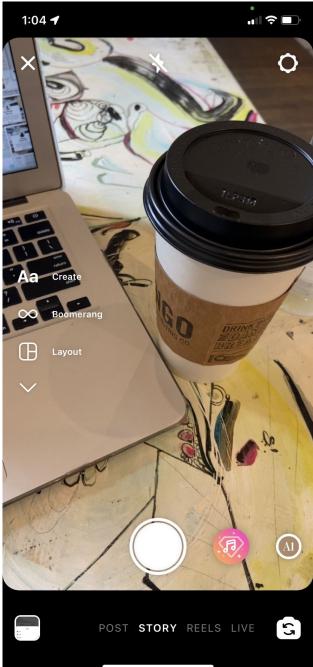
Stories are short, temporary posts that appear at the top of a users feed. They allow you to share moments in your day quickly and easily.

Why are stories important?

- Stories quickly remind your audience of who you are and what your brand is about
- Instant feedback on your product or service
- In 2019, 500 million people used Instagram Stories every day
- Instagram Stories account for 34% of Instagrams sponsored content
- You can highlight specific products or events









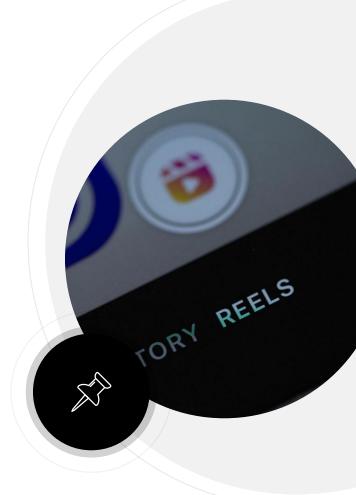
Utilizing Reels

What are Reels?

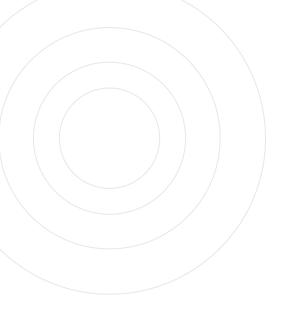
Much like TikTok, Instagram Reels are video shorts that allow you to quickly feature your brand to your audience.

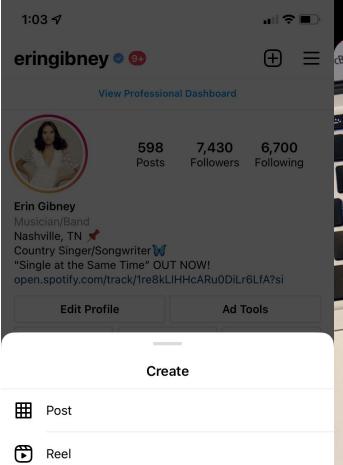
These reels are pushed to non-followers as well, giving your brand an opportunity for greater reach.

These posts are permanent unless deleted and they are stored under the "Reels" icon on a user's Home Page.

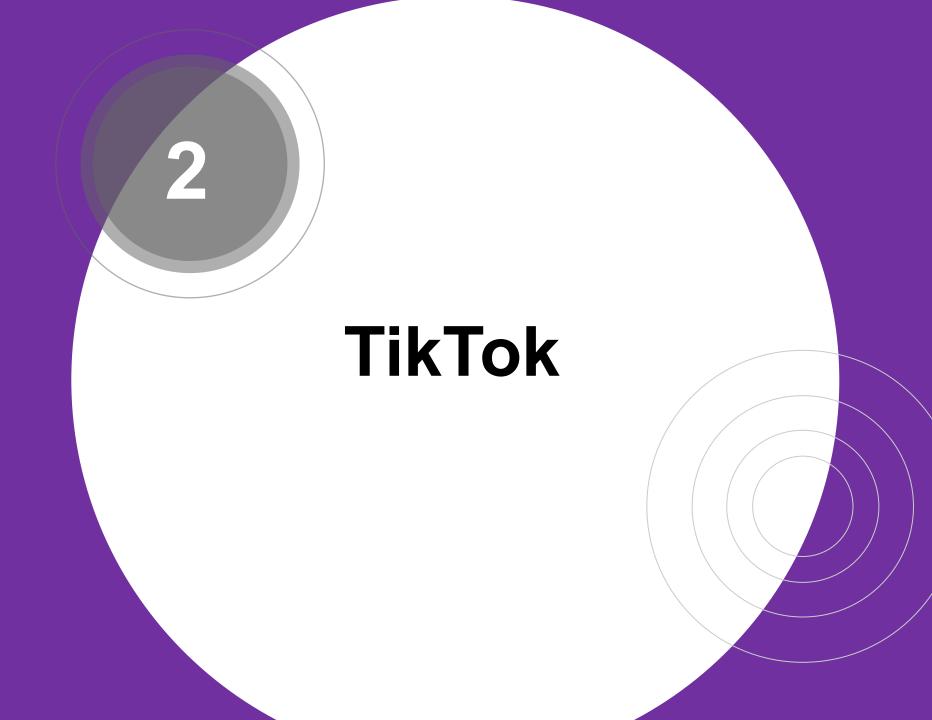
Using TikToks As Reels

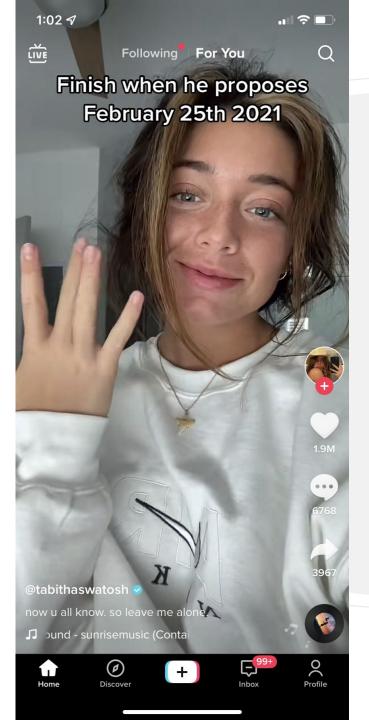


Using Trending Hashtags and Sounds

- TikTok features trending hashtags from every niche.





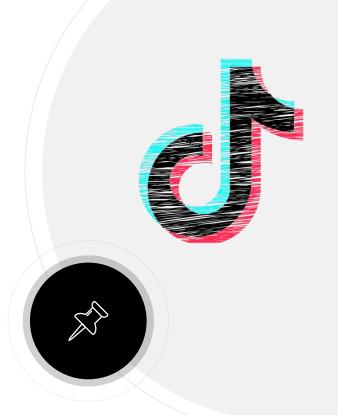


The For You Page

Getting on the For You page is the goal for virtually every creator on TikTok.

Here on some tips on getting your video on the For You page:

- Ask questions in your video to drive user interactions
- Tell a multi-part story so that users will keep coming back to your page.
- Keep videos 15 seconds or under

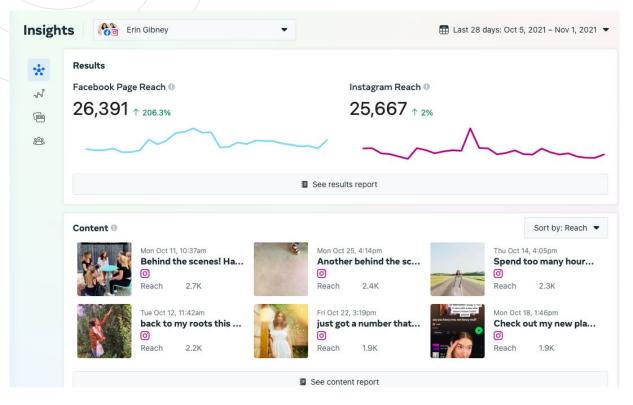
Making a Facebook Business account allows you to track your analytics and see which of your content is performing the best.

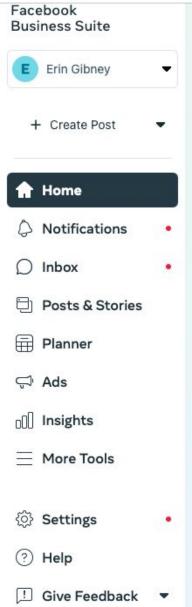

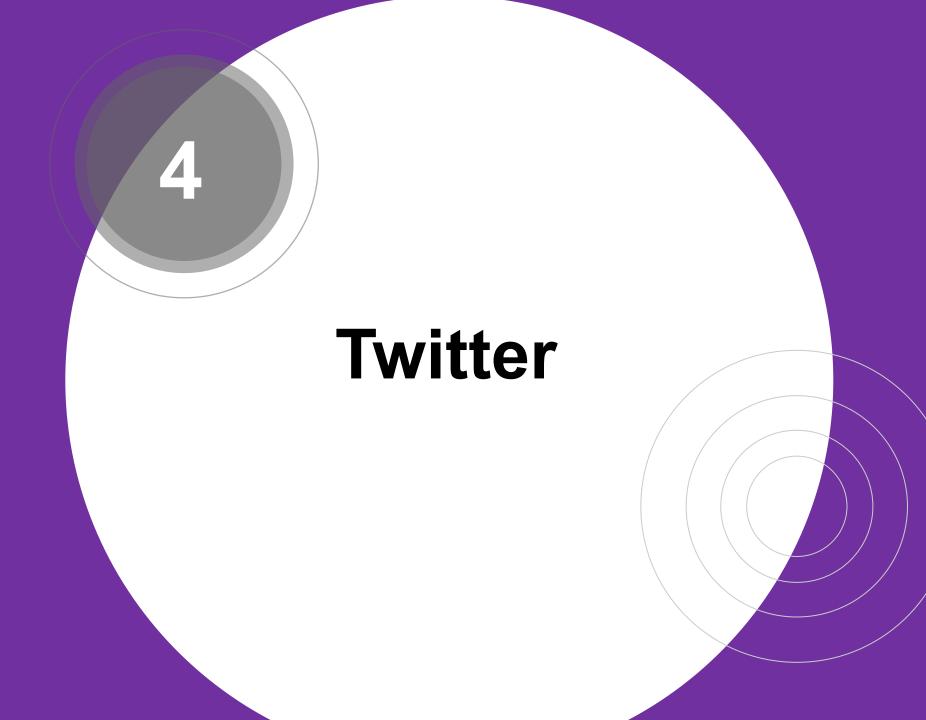

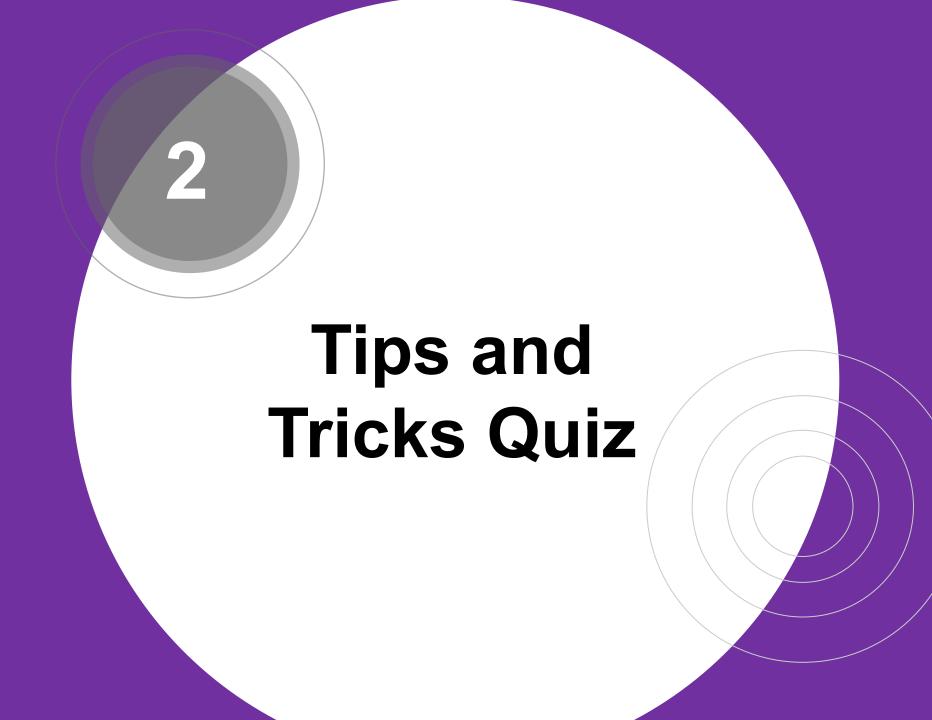
